Each session is 2.5 hours long (including a comfort break). Staff also receive one thirty minute one- to one personalised coaching session allowing them to get further support. This coaching session takes place within a month of the last training session.

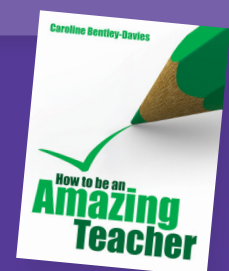
